

SIGNATURE PETITION INSTRUCTIONS FOR DON BATES JR FOR US SENATE:

Be certain to mark each sheet you are gathering signatures on with the County they are from in the event a sheet does have multiple counties included this can be sorted out on our end but we want this left to a minimum due to the amount of work that goes into sorting that out. Please confirm with me at the end of each week the total number of signatures you have gathered from each county.

We are asking that you return to us all signature petitions to the campaign at P.O. Box 1026 Anderson IN 46015, no later than January 30th 2010. You may continue gathering signatures after this date but you should send what you gather regularly to our campaign so that they are sure to be certified and counted.

Please note, any registered voter in Indiana can sign these petitions, it does not matter if they plan to vote Republican, Democrat, Independent or Libertarian (in Indiana registered voters declare their party at the polling site or in their absentee ballot request), or if they have voted one way or another in the past, also if someone has signed another Senate petition it does not exempt them from signing Don's as well, it is merely a petition to be placed on the ballot, not an indication that they have made a decision on who they will vote for in May.

Attached to this email is the Indiana form in PDF format. To help, print out the form and follow the instructions below. Also, email this information to people you know in other parts of the state.

1. PRINT OUT ONLY THE FIRST PAGE OF THE FORM (the second page will be added by Hostettler's campaign when they get the signatures certified).
2. Designate the county at the top right of the form.
3. The potential signer must be a registered voter in the county designated on the form.
4. Signers must be residents of the county designated at the top of the form.
5. Signers can sign petitions for more than one candidate.
6. Signer is to fill out:
 - Their signature
 - PRINT their first and last name
 - Their date of birth (in MM/DD/YYYY format)
 - PRINT their RESIDENCE address - NO P.O. BOXES
 - PRINT their RESIDENCE city or town and zip code

SIGNATURE PETITION INSTRUCTIONS FOR MARLIN STUTZMAN FOR US SENATE:

- Print both front and back of the petition onto the same paper.

or

Print the front of the petition and the campaign office will add the back page later.

- Assign the appropriate county at the top right hand corner of the form.
- If you are a registered voter in the state of Indiana, you may sign the form that has your designated county printed at the top right hand corner.

- Please legibly print the following information:
 - ✓ First and Last name

 - ✓ Address (please no P.O. Boxes)

- Please do not put any other information on the form. The last two columns will be handled by the county clerks.
